



Student Code of Conduct

Punctuality, assiduity, absence

As to not disturb students who are already present as well as the instructor, students are required to arrive on time to class. In case of accidental tardiness, before entering the class, the student is required to ask permission to enter from either the instructor or their assistant. Furthermore, to encourage a continuous and homogenous group progression, students are advised to assist classes on a regular basis. In the case of absence, please try to warn the instructor in advance.

Dress code

Students are required to be adequately dressed when taking part in classes. Also, before leaving the training center, students need to make sure not to forget any of their belongings (sport or taekwondo gear).

Before arriving to class, students should pay attention to taking off all jewelry (rings, ear rings, bracelets, watches, etc.).

Changing Rooms

A changing area is at the disposition of the students for them to change or leave their things. However, students are asked not to leave any valuable objects as they are not under any surveillance. The foundation declines any responsibility in case of theft or loss.

Presence of Parents

In order not to distract students and make sure that they are focused, parents are not advised to be present in class. Nevertheless, parents may be present for the very first classes as well as on special occasions.

Conduct and Behavior of Students

The behavior and attitudes of students play an important part in preserving a positive image of taekwondo. Below is a code of conduct which each student needs to follow in class.

- Be respectful of others, polite and courteous
- Do not be aggressive
- Stay silent and concentrated during instructions given by the instructor
- Do not raise your voice, chew gum or wear jewelry
- Do not enter or leave class without having been given permission to do so by the instructor
- Be patient, do not get discouraged and show confidence in your instructor
- Obey the code of conduct and be a good role model to others
- Greet the instructor when entering and leaving class
- Give yourself long-term objectives
